**SUMMARY ORDER**

NOW, on this 12th day of March, 1994, this matter comes on before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter referred to as "Board") sitting as a whole as presiding officer in a summary proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 77-537 through 77-541, the Application for License by Endorsement filed by Andre W. Van As, M.D. (hereafter "Applicant") to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, appears before and on behalf of the Board. Applicant appears in person and by his counsel, Steve A. Schwarm of Topeka.

After reviewing the application and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. On February 23, 1994, Applicant filed an Application for License by Endorsement to obtain a permanent license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

2. As part of that application, Applicant provided information and documentation regarding postgraduate training which had been obtained by Applicant outside of the United States. Such

information provided evidence that Applicant had completed at least three years of postgraduate training.

3. That from and since filing the Application for License by Endorsement, Applicant has provided additional information in support of his application.

4. That from information provided, it appears that the postgraduate training obtained by Applicant as well as other professional activities including teaching positions in the United States is equivalent to at least one year of such training had it been obtained in the United States and Applicant's application is complete and should be granted.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** as follows:

a) That the findings here and above made be in the same and are made the Order of the Board.

b) Applicant's Application for License by Endorsement is deemed complete and Applicant should be placed on the list for consideration for licensure which will be considered by the Board at its meeting to be held April 16, 1994.


c) That prior to the Board taking action on Applicant's license at its meeting on April 16, 1994, Applicant may receive a temporary permit under the provision of K.S.A. 65-2811(a)(1) by submitting to the Board the appropriate fee for such temporary permit.

c) Either party is entitled to an administrative review of this Order if a written request is received in the Board office within five days of service of this Order upon the parties.
