SUMMARY ORDER OF CANCELLATION OF LICENSE

NOW, on this 21st day of February, 2005, this matter comes before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director, Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), in summary proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537.

After reviewing the agency record and being duly advised in the premises, the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders are made for and on behalf of the Board:

1. License number 4-22536 issued to Gopi Vasudevan, M.D. ("Licensee") to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas expired on June 30, 2004 pursuant to K.A.R. 100-15-1.
2. On or about June 24, 2004, Licensee submitted an application for license renewal for the period of 2004-2005 by utilizing the on-line process.
3. K.A.R. 100-15-2 requires every licensee rendering health care service in Kansas to submit with the renewal, evidence of satisfactory completion of a program of continuing education.
4. As part of the on-line process, Licensee certified that 50 hours of continuing education credit hours had been completed.
5. As part of the on-line renewal process, Licensee further certified that the notice regarding the Board's procedures for auditing continuing education compliance had been read.
6. Licensee was randomly selected to provide verification of compliance with the continuing

education requirements and on December 30, 2004 was mailed a letter requesting that Licensee provide, no later than January 31, 2005, the continuing education records relied upon when Licensee certified that he had achieved the 50 continuing education hours required by K.A.R. 100-15-2.

7. As of February 21, 2005, Licensee has failed to provide to the Board documented evidence of completion of a minimum of 50 hours of continuing medical education.


8. By failing to provide documented evidence of completion of the required continuing medical education, Licensee has not met the requirements for license renewal for the period July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the license issued by the Board to Licensee to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas is canceled effective March 21, 2005 due to failure to renew as provided by K.S.A. 65-2809.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Summary Order. A party to whom a Summary Order is issued may file a written request for a hearing within 15 days following service of the Summary Order. If a hearing is not requested, the Summary Order shall become effective as a Final Order of the Board upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing. 
