

NOW, on this 23rd day of June 2008, the above-entitled matter comes on before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts. After reviewing the file and being duly advised in the premises, the Executive Director makes the following determinations.

1. On June 2, 2008, the Executive Director, on behalf of the Board, issued a Summary Order under Policy 05-04 in which it was determined that Christina Vignery, RT should be assessed a fine in the amount of \$250.00, payable within 30 days of the effective date of the order, for failure to have met the continuing education requirements at the time she renewed her license, and should provide documentation of completion of at least 9.5 continuing education hours within 90 days of the effective date of this order.


2. The Summary Order contained a notice that a written request for hearing could be filed within 15 days following service, but if no hearing is requested, the Summary Order would become effective as a final order of the Board upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing.

3. No hearing has been requested by any party and, therefore, the Summary Order became effective on June 23, 2008; and as stated in the Summary Order a civil fine of \$250.00 is payable within 30 days of the effective date and documentation of

completion of at least 9.5 continuing education hours shall be provided within 90 days of the effective date.



SUMMARY ORDER

NOW, on this 2^d day of June 2008, this matter comes before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), in summary proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537.

After reviewing the agency record and being duly advised in the premises, the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders are made for and on behalf of the Board:

1. License number 16-03213 issued to Christina Vignery, RT ("Licensee") to practice as a respiratory therapist in the state of Kansas expired on March 31, 2008, pursuant to K.A.R. 100-55-6.
2. K.A.R.100-55-7 requires each Licensee desiring to renew a respiratory therapist license to submit to the Board documented evidence of completion of a minimum of 12 contact hours of continuing education since April 1 of the previous year before or with the request for renewal.
3. On or about March 29, 2008, Licensee submitted an application for renewal of the license.
4. As part of the online renewal process, Licensee certified that the rules regarding proof of continuing education had been read, that the required number of continuing education

hours had been achieved, and that documentation of those hours would be maintained for a three-year period and produced to the Board upon request.

5. As part of the renewal process, Licensee further certified that the notice regarding the Board's procedures for auditing continuing education compliance had been read.

6. Licensee was randomly selected to provide verification of compliance with the continuing education requirements and on February 28, 2008, was mailed a letter requesting that Licensee provide, no later than March 31, 2008, the records relied upon when Licensee certified achievement of the continuing education hours.

7. On May 29, 2008, Licensee provided documentation of the achievement of 7.25 continuing education hours.

8. On May 29, 2008, Licensee provided a letter stating that she had made an error in the calculation of continuing education hours and does not have the required 12 continuing education hours.

9. Licensee has failed to provide documented evidence of completion of 12 continuing education hours since April 1 of the previous year.

10. Based on the Policy Statement No. 05-04, a Licensee who has deficient continuing education hours shall complete twice the number of deficient continuing education hours within 90 days and be fined the sum of \$250.00.

11. Based on the information provided by Licensee, Licensee was deficient a total of 4.75 continuing education hours when the license was renewed; therefore, Licensee needs to complete 9.5 continuing education hours in accordance with Policy Statement No. 05-04.

12. Based on the Policy Statement 05-04, Licensee should be assessed a civil fine in the amount of \$250.00, payable within 30 days of the effective date of this order for the failure to have had the required continuing education at the time of renewal.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the license of Licensee is assessed a civil fine in the amount of \$250.00, payable within 30 days of the effective date of this order, for failure to have met the continuing education requirements at the time of renewal.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Licensee shall provide documentation of completion of 9.5 continuing education hours within 90 days of the effective date of this order.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a summary order. A party to whom a summary order is issued may file a written request for a hearing within 15 days following service of the summary order. If a hearing is not requested, the summary order shall become effective as a final order of the Board upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing. 
