FINAL ORDER TERMINATING CONSENT ORDER

On October 8, 2021 this matter came before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) for a Conference Hearing on the request of Reggie J. Voboril, M.D. (“Licensee”) to terminate her Consent Order. Licensee appeared in person via teleconference, *pro se*. Matthew Gaus, Associate Litigation Counsel, appeared to present the position of the Disciplinary Panel of the Board.

Under the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, (“KAPA”), K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board enters this Final Order. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the arguments of the parties, and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions, and orders.

1. On August 15, 2016, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board, imposing requirements therein.
2. On or about July 2, 2021, Licensee requested termination of the Consent Order.
3. Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order and has no further obligations for compliance with the Consent Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, the Consent Order Licensee entered into with the Board on August 15, 2016, is hereby **TERMINATED**.


