SUMMARY ORDER DENYING APPLICATION

NOW, on this 25th day of May, 2004, comes on before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), the Application for Registration as a Physical Therapist filed by Ginah Vrooman ("Applicant"). After reviewing the file and being duly advised in the premises, the Executive Director makes the following findings and orders for and on behalf of the Board:

1. Applicant filed an Application for Registration as a Physical Therapist with the Board on January 13, 2004.
2. Effective April 1, 2004, the credentialing status of physical therapists was changed from registration to licensure and the application filed by Applicant is considered an Application for Licensure as a Physical Therapist.
3. Applicant has provided information to the Board indicating graduation from the De La Salle University-Emilio Aguinaldo College, Dasmaringas, Cavite, Philippines.
4. The Emilio Aguinaldo College, Dasmaringas, Cavite, Philippines is not an educational program in physical therapy approved by the Board.
5. K.A.R. 100-29-3 provides that each person who received education from a school not approved by the Board shall submit with the Application for Licensure, an evaluation prepared for the state of Kansas by a board-approved credentialing agency.

6. On February 5, 2004, the Board received a Physical Therapy Educational Evaluation Checklist from International Credentialing Associates, Inc., a credentials evaluation service.

7. International Credentialing Associates, Inc. has been approved by the Board as a credentialing agency.

8. K.A.R. 100-29-2 provides that if an applicant for licensure received a degree from a program that was not approved by the Board at the time of an applicant's graduation, the Board may consider whether the program was equivalent to physical therapy schools that were approved by the American Physical Therapy Association at that time.


9. From the information provided as part of the application, Applicant has not successfully completed the academic requirements of a program in physical therapy which is appropriate for licensure of Applicant as a physical therapist in the state of Kansas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Application for Licensure as a Physical Therapist filed by Ginah Vrooman is **DENIED**.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a summary order. A party to whom a summary order is issued may file a written request for a hearing within 15 days following service of the summary order. If a hearing is not requested, the summary order shall become effective as a final order of the Board upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing.
