ORDER OF RETROACTIVE REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

- 4. Licensee's failure to renew the license in a timely manner was the result of excusable inadvertence.
- 5. For good cause shown, Licensee's license should be retroactively reinstated to show

- That the findings here and above made be and the same are made the order of the Board.
- 2. That the license of Them Le Vu, M.D. to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas originally issued December 9, 2000 be made effective retroactively from and after August 1, 2002.
