**FINAL ORDER DENYING LICENSURE BY ENDORSEMENT**

**NOW** on this 12<sup>th</sup> day of April 2012, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the application of Khanh Vu, M.D. (“Applicant”) for licensure by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Applicant appears in person and *pro se*. Reese H. Hays, Counsel, appears on behalf of the Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801, *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, the submitted exhibits, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. Applicant submitted an application for licensure by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Such application was complete and filed with the Board on or about March 15, 2013.
2. In 1995, Applicant graduated from Laval University Faculty of Medicine in Quebec, Canada.
3. Applicant’s postgraduate training is not accredited by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME). In June 2006, Applicant successfully completed a

5-year residency in radiation oncology in Ontario, Canada, which is accredited by the Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Canada. In May of 2007, she completed a 6-month fellowship in radiation oncology in Ontario, Canada. Applicant also participated in a residency program from August of 2009 to July of 2010, at the Tom Baker Cancer Center in Alberta, Canada, but did not successfully complete the program.

4. Applicant presently holds a license to practice medicine and surgery in the States of New York, Illinois and Pennsylvania, having been issued such licenses in 2012, 2012 and 2010 respectively.

5. Applicant practiced as a staff radiation oncologist at Allan Blair Cancer Center in Saskatchewan, Canada from July of 2007 to June of 2009.


6. Applicant has practiced in the United States for one month as a *locum* radiation oncologist at Memorial Cancer Center in Springfield, Illinois from March to April of 2012.

7. The Board finds that Applicant has not engaged in sufficient active practice under her New York, Illinois or Pennsylvania licenses to warrant licensure by endorsement in State of Kansas. Specifically, Applicant has only practiced for one (1) month in the last four (4) years.

8. The Board concludes that Applicant has not satisfactorily fulfilled K.S.A. 65-2833 to be granted a license by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS** that Applicant's application for a license by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas is hereby DENIED.
