STIPULATION

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 31st day of May, 1987, by and between the KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS, hereinafter referred to as "Board" and PAUL E. WAKIM, D.O., hereinafter referred to as "Licensee".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, between October 1, 1983 and July 31, 1986, the Board received notification that Licensee had been named as defendant in fifteen malpractice suits, and

WHEREAS, the Disciplinary Counsel for the Board has read the aforementioned petitions, and

WHEREAS, allegations contained in the aforementioned petitions may constitute grounds to have Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas revoked, suspended or limited, and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to enter into a Stipulation in lieu of proceeding with any further investigations, reviews and/or disciplinary proceedings as defined by the Statutes of the State of Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the forbearance of any further investigations, reviews, and/or disciplinary proceedings and the other covenants or promises contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The Board agrees to take no disciplinary action against the Licensee based upon the aforementioned malpractice petitions until such time as Licensee has advised the Board as hereinafter indicated that he desires to actively engage in the practice of medicine and surgery within the State of Kansas.

2. That, Licensee agrees to give the Board at least ninety (90) days notice prior to actively engaging in the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

3. That, Licensee waives a speedy determination of this matter and agrees that the Board may undertake such further investigation, review and institute such proceedings as it deems appropriate regarding Licensee's medical and surgical abilities at such time

as Licensee has notified the Board he desires to actively engage in the practice of medicine and surgery within the State of Kansas.

4. The conditions herein set forth are to be strictly construed and adhered to. Should Licensee engage in the active practice of medicine and surgery within the State of Kansas without first providing the Board with required notice as hereinabove stated the Board may institute formal proceedings against Licensee for the revocation, suspension or limitation of the license of Licensee to practice medicine and surgery within the State of Kansas.

5. This Stipulation shall remain in full force and effect until it is modified by written agreement by and between both parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Stipulation on the date indicated below their signature, it being specifically and expressly understood that this Stipulation shall not become effective until such time as it has been signed by both of the parties hereto.
