ORDER TERMINATING STIPULATION AND DISSOLVING ENFORCEMENT ORDER

NOW, on this 9th day of February, 1991, comes on for consideration, the request of Paul E. Wakim, D.O., (hereafter "Licensee") for termination of Stipulation.

After reviewing the file and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") makes the following findings of fact and orders:

1. The Board and Licensee entered into a Stipulation dated May 31, 1987, in which Licensee agreed to give to the Board, at least 90 days notice prior to actively engaging in the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

2. On June 13, 1987, the Board issued an Enforcement Order based upon the conditions as stated in the aforementioned Stipulation.

3. Licensee has requested that the aforementioned Stipulation be terminated and the Enforcement Order based thereon be dissolved.

4. From and since the execution of the Stipulation and the issuance of the Enforcement Order, Licensee has practiced outside

of the State of Kansas and has met all of the conditions of the Stipulation.

5. The Stipulation between the Board and Licensee dated May 31, 1987 should be terminated and the Enforcement Order issued by the Board pursuant thereto dated June 13, 1987 should be dissolved.


6. With the termination of the Stipulation and the dissolution of the Enforcement Order, Licensee should be discharged from any and all restrictions which such had imposed on his license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE BOARD that the Stipulation dated May 31, 1987 between the Licensee and the Board be terminated in its entirety and shall hereafter have no further force or effect; that the Enforcement Order based upon the Stipulation between Licensee and Board dated June 13, 1987 be hereby dissolved; and that the license of Licensee to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas shall hereafter be without any other restrictions which had been imposed by either the Stipulation or the Enforcement Order.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


