NOW ON THIS Fourteenth Day of October, 2000, comes before the Board a request by Carolyn M. Waldo, M.D. for approval of a monitoring physician. Dr. Waldo appears *pro se*. Kelli J. Benintendi, Associate Counsel, appears and provides information on behalf of the Board.

Dr. Waldo withdraws her request for approval of a monitoring physician, and requests that the Board terminate the Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order dated February 14, 2000, pursuant to which Dr. Waldo is limited to practicing in a group setting with ongoing monitoring by a licensed physician approved by the Board. For good cause shown, the Board grants this request.


