Order Staying Petition

On August 10, 2018, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") held the conference hearing on the Petition for discipline filed against the license to practice medicine and surgery of Gail Walter, M.D. ("Licensee"). Jared Langford, Associate Litigation Counsel, appeared on behalf of the Board. Licensee appeared in person and pro se.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2901, et seq., and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, et seq., the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the arguments of the parties, and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions, and orders.

Findings of Fact

Licensee was issued a license to practice of medicine and surgery in Kansas, having been issued License No. 04-23221 on June 15, 1990, and having last renewed such license on July 14, 2017. On December 14, 2017, the Missouri State Board of Registration for the Healing Arts revoked Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in Missouri. On July 31, 2018, Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas cancelled for failure to renew. Licensee does not practice in Kansas, has no plans to reinstate her license, and currently lives and works outside the United States of America.

Conclusions

Immediate action against Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas is not necessary because Licensee's license is cancelled, and Licensee no longer practices in Kansas.

Orders

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that the Petition for discipline filed against Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery is stayed until Licensee reinstates her license to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas.
