JOURNAL ENTRY OF SATISFACTION

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq*, and upon due consideration of the agency record, applicable statutes and regulation, and being duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. On March April 17, 2015, Timothy D. Warren, D.C. (“Licensee”) entered into a Final Order with the Board.
2. The Final Order required Licensee to attend and successfully complete the Medical Record keeping Seminar offered by the Center for Personalized Education, to attend and successfully complete 10 hours of continuing education in the areas of risk management and/or document strategies, and write an article for public dissemination which addresses the issue of sports physicals being medical records to be reviewed by a designated Board Member.
3. On October 28, 2015, the Board received documentation evidencing attendance and successful completion of the Medical Record keeping Seminar offered by the Center for Personalized Education.
4. On November 2, 2015, the Board received documentation evidencing attendance and successful completion of 12 hours of continuing education.

5. On June 19, 2015, Licensee submitted his article to the designated Board Member, who suggested changes. On July 19, 2015, Licensee again submitted his article which was received and reviewed by the Board Member with no further changes suggested.
6. Licensee has met all requirements of the Final Order and has no further obligation for compliance.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee is hereby discharged from all requirements of the Final Order.
