FINAL ORDER

NOW this 16th day of June, 2009, the above captioned matter comes before the Board on the Petition for Reconsideration by the licensee, Thomas C. Weaver, D.C. The petitioner appears Ronald P. Pope of Ralston, Pope and Diehl, LLC. Board staff appears by and through Janith Davis. There are no other appearances. The Board after reviewing the file, the petition for reconsideration and the response thereto and after being duly apprised of the premises finds as follows:

1. The license of Thomas C. Weaver, D.C. was suspended for violation of the Kansas Healing Arts Act.
2. The suspension of the license of Thomas C. Weaver, D.C. was stayed pending completion of ordered professional practice monitoring.
3. Thomas C. Weaver, D.C. did not comply with the order of the Board.
4. The Board was justified in lifting the stay of the suspension of the license of Thomas C. Weaver.
5. Thomas C. Weaver, D.C. has not given justification for his failure to comply with the Board's Orders.


WHEREUPON, the Motion of Thomas C. Weaver, D.C. for Reconsideration is DENIED. Thomas C. Weaver, D.C.'s license to practice chiropractic is SUSPENDED

pursuant to the original term of suspension as issued by the Board. Thomas C. Weaver, D.C. shall not practice chiropractic subject to further Order of the Board.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a final order. A final order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a final order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, et seq. Reconsideration of a final order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the final order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon Jack Confer, the Board's Acting Executive Director, at 235 SW Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603.
