**FINAL ORDER TERMINATING PRACTICE  
RESTRICTIONS AND MONITORING**

**NOW** on this 14th day of August, 2015, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the request of Kimberly West, M.D. (“Licensee”) for termination of the practice restrictions and monitoring requirement contained in the Consent Order filed on June 16, 2014. Licensee appears in person, and by and through her counsel, Megan Lewis of Simpson, Logback, Lynch, Norris, P.A.. Jane Weiler, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, receiving evidence, and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. On June 10, 2015, Licensee submitted a request to the Board for termination of the practice restrictions and the monitoring provisions contained in her Consent Order.
2. On July 14, 2015, the Respondent Board filed a Response to Petition to Terminate Practice Restrictions and Monitoring and included documentary evidence of Licensee’s compliance with her monitoring requirement.

3. Licensee's monitoring contract, which she entered into June 30, 2014, provided that Licensee could request termination after a period of one (1) year.

4. Assistant Litigation Counsel moves the Board to admit Board Exhibit D. Licensee does not object. Exhibit D is admitted into the agency record.


5. Licensee requests the Board terminate the practice restrictions and monitoring requirements of her Consent Order effective August 21, 2015.

6. Based upon the documentary evidence submitted and arguments at the hearing, the Board finds that Licensee has at this time satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order and that such practice restrictions and monitoring requirements of the Consent Order shall terminate on August 21, 2015.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS** that the monitoring requirements imposed by the Consent Order filed on June 16, 2014, are hereby **TERMINATED as of August 21, 2015** and that Licensee shall have no further obligation for compliance.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529, Licensee may petition the Board for Reconsideration of a Final Order within fifteen (15) days following service of the final order. Additionally, a party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court, as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, *et seq.* Reconsideration of a Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within **30 days** following service of the Final Order. 
