

2. On March 29, 1992, Applicant affixed his signature to a Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order which became an Order of the Board April 15, 1992.

3. Under paragraph 7(d) of the aforementioned Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order, certain limitations and restrictions were placed upon the license of Applicant as a condition for Applicant engaging in the practice of medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.

4. By letter dated May 18, 1992, Applicant requested modification of the Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order.

5. In an Order Denying Modification of Stipulation and Agreement filed June 23, 1992, the Board denied the request to permit payment of the civil fine assessed in paragraph 7(d)(i) of said Stipulation by a appropriate payment schedule.

6. On October 26, 1992, Applicant filed an Application for Reinstatement of his license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.

7. That the Application for Reinstatement of license is not complete and is missing the following requirements:

- a. Verification of licensure status from the state of Tennessee.
- b. AMA Physician Profile.
- c. Completion of a status change form to "inactive" status.
- d. One professional recommendation.

8. That a money order dated October 22, 1992 made payable to the Order of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts in the amount of \$7,500 has been received on behalf of Applicant in full payment of the civil fine assessed and agreed to by Applicant in paragraph 7(d)(i) of the Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order.

9. That from and since the execution and filing of the Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order, the license of Applicant to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas has been cancelled and Applicant has not engaged in the practice of medicine and surgery in this state. That paragraph 7(d)(ii) should be modified to reflect that Licensee should be required to comply with the quarterly reporting system established thereby at such time as Applicant seeks to reinstate his license on an "active" status and commences the active practice of medicine and surgery in this state.


10. That except as hereinabove modified, the Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order filed April 15, 1992 should remain in full force and effect and is not otherwise modified or amended by this Order.

11. That upon receipt of the missing requirements as hereinabove specified in paragraph 7, the Board staff is authorized and directed to reinstate the license of Applicant on an "inactive" status.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the findings hereinabove made be and the same are hereby made the Order of the Board.
