FINAL ORDER DENYING THIRD TEMPORARY PERMIT

NOW, on this 15th day of October, 1994, comes on for conference proceedings the request of Kimberly Kay Wilcox, (hereafter "Applicant") to grant a third temporary permit pursuant to K.A.R. 100-36-1.

Applicant does not appear. Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, appears on behalf of the Board. There are no other appearances.

After reviewing the files and being duly advised in the premises, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") makes the following findings of facts, conclusions of law and order:

- A request for a third temporary permit was filed by Applicant on October
 1994.
- 2. A Voluntary Entry of Appearance and Waiver of Notice was filed October
- 14, 1994 by Applicant consenting to the Board conducting a conference

proceeding on the request for a third temporary permit on October 15, 1994 at 1:15 p.m.

- 3. Applicant has applied for permanent registration as a physical therapist assistant, but has not passed an examination approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 65-2906 as amended by 1994 House Bill No. 2787..
- 4. Applicant was issued a temporary permit on August 27, 1993, which expired February 15, 1993, and was subsequently issued a second temporary permit issued on January 10, 1994, which expired October 15, 1994.
- 5. Pursuant to K.A.R. 100-36-1, not more than two temporary permits shall be issued to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board and only for good cause shown.
- 6. Applicant has failed the examination twice, on November 17, 1993, with a score of 74 and on July 13, 1994, with a score of 576.
- 7. Applicant has failed to provide good cause for the granting of a third temporary permit.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a third temporary permit for the purposes of holding oneself out as a physical therapist assistant shall not be issued to Applicant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within 15 days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


