JOURNAL ENTRY

NOW this 4<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2009, the above captioned matter comes before the Board on the respondent, Charlene Williams, M.D.'s motion to vacate the Board's Order of August 14, 2009. After review of the file, the motion of licensee, the responses of staff and being duly apprised of the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. The Board entered a default order dated August 14, 2009 revoking the license to practice medicine of Charlene Williams, M.D.

2. Charlene Williams, M.D., is a Captain in the active service of the United States Air Force.

3. As an active member of the United States Air Force, the respondent is protected by the Service Members Civil Relief Act, 50 U.S.C. 501 et seq.

4. The Service Members Civil Relief Act prohibits the Board from entering a default judgment against the respondent.

5. The Service Members Civil Relief Act, 50 U.S.C. App. 522, requires the Board to stay proceedings for 90 days to allow the respondent the opportunity to mount a defense and obtain leave to appear before the Board.

WHEREUPON, after due consideration, the Board:

A. VACATES the default judgment dated August 14, 2009 in the above captioned matter;

B. STAYS the proceedings in this case for 90 days from the date of this order;


C. Appoints Michael Beezley, M.D. as Presiding Officer to hear the merits of this case and issue an Initial Order;

D. Retains jurisdiction of these proceedings to hear evidence and enter subsequent orders as needed.
