FINAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS 23rd day of September, 2009, comes Jack Confer, Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) and finds and states as follows:

1. On July 22, 2009, a copy of the Notice of Conference Hearing on the Petition to revoke, suspend, fine or limit the Licensee’s License was mailed to Charlene Williams, MD (“Respondent”), at 22800 Bulverde RD, Apt. 1801, San Antonio, TX 78261. The notice was not returned as undeliverable.
2. Respondent did not attend the Conference Hearing conducted on August 14, 2009 at which time the Board found Respondent to be in default and issued a Proposed Default Order which was filed on September 10, 2009.
3. A copy of the Proposed Default Order was mailed to Respondent at 22800 Bulverde RD, Apt. 1801, San Antonio, TX 78261. The notice was not returned as undeliverable.

4. K.S.A. 77-520 provides that a party against whom a Proposed Default Order is issued may file a written motion within seven (7) days after service of the order requesting that the order be vacated, and if a motion is not so filed, the Proposed Default Order shall become effective.
5. Respondent has not filed a motion requesting that the Proposed Default Order be vacated and, therefore, by operation of law, the Proposed Default Order became effective September 21, 2009, and Respondent's License to Practice Medicine and Surgery in the State of Kansas is revoked as of that date.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a final order. A final order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a final order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, et seq. Reconsideration of a final order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the final order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon the Board's Executive Director at 235 SW. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603.


