FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 15th day of October, 1994, comes on for conference proceedings the request of Barbara Lynn Williams (hereafter "Applicant") to grant a second temporary registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5508.

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, appears on behalf of the Board. Applicant appeared in person <u>pro</u> <u>se</u>. There are no other appearances.

After reviewing the files and being duly advised in the premises, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") makes the following findings of facts, conclusions of law and order:

- 1. On September 23, 1994, a request for a second temporary registration was received from Applicant to practice as a respiratory therapist in the State of Kansas.
- 2. A Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 1:15 p.m. on October 15, 1994 was filed herein on September 30, 1994 and served on Applicant on that same date.
- 3. Applicant has applied for permanent registration as a respiratory therapist, but has not passed an examination required

and approved by the Board for registration as a respiratory therapist pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5506.

- 4. Applicant was granted a temporary registration on September 27, 1993 which expired on September 27, 1994.
- 5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5508(e) no more than one such temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.
- 6. Applicant should be granted a second temporary registration effective September 27, 1994 and to expire September 27, 1995.

registration for the purposes of holding oneself out as a respiratory therapist be issued to Applicant effective from September 27, 1994 and to expire on September 27, 1995 upon payment of the required fee for such second temporary registration.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within 15 days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
