**ORDER EMERGENTLY SUSPENDING LICENSE
AND APPOINTING PRESIDING OFFICER**

NOW, on this 11th day of April, 2014, this matter comes before the Board for conference hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) on the Petition filed in the above-entitled matter on March 3, 2014. Anne Hall, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears for the Petitioner Board. Sheila Williamson, M.D. (“Licensee”) appears *pro se*.

Whereupon the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. A Petition alleging violations of the Kansas healing arts act and seeking disciplinary action against Licensee’s license was filed on March 3, 2014. The Petition, in part, alleges that Licensee previously had her hospital privileges suspended in 2008, Confidential Confidential

2. Pursuant to a Notice of Conference Hearing on the Petition, a conference hearing was held at the Board offices on April 11, 2014. During the conference hearing, the Board converted the proceedings to a formal hearing to hear testimony Confidential and based on Licensee’s stated dispute of at least some of the factual allegations in the Petition.

5. K.S.A. 65-2836(i) provides grounds for disciplinary action against a licensee's license if "[t]he licensee has the inability to practice the healing arts with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of physical or mental illness, or condition or use of alcohol, drugs or controlled substances."

6. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2838(c), the Board may temporarily suspend a licensee's license in accordance with the emergency adjudicative proceedings of the Kansas administrative procedure act set forth in K.S.A. 77-536, if the Board determines there is cause to believe that grounds exist under K.S.A. 65-2836 for disciplinary action against the licensee and that the licensee's continuation in practice would constitute an imminent danger to the public health and safety.

7. There is cause to believe Licensee's ability to practice medicine is impaired to a degree which would violate K.S.A. 65-2836(i) Confidential
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Furthermore, Licensee's continuation in practice while impaired constitutes an imminent danger to the public health and safety.

8. Licensee's license should be emergently suspended pending a further hearing on the need for the continuation of the emergency suspension.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the license of Sheila Williamson, M.D., is hereby temporarily suspended on an emergency basis.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Board member Michael Beezley, M.D. is hereby appointed as Presiding Officer to conduct a hearing on this emergency order as soon as practicable to determine the need for continuing the emergency suspension.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
