ORDER

NOW on this 19th day of October, 1996, comes the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") for Finding of Facts and an Enforcement Order of the stipulation and agreement of the Board, by and through Shelly Gasper, Assistant General Counsel, and Applicant, Wayne W. Williamson, D.O. by and through his attorney, Bradley D. Honnold.

After reviewing the file, hearing the statements of counsel and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Applicant has made application to the Board for reinstatement of his license to practice osteopathy in the state of Kansas.
2. Applicant's application for reinstatement revealed that grounds exist to deny Applicant's application for reinstatement. Specifically, the following grounds constitute a basis for denial or limitation of license pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2836:
3. Applicant has had disciplinary action taken against him by the proper licensing authority of the State of Missouri in violation of K.S.A. 65-2836(j).

4. The licensee has prescribed, sold, administered, distributed or given a controlled substance to any person for other than medically accepted or lawful purposes.K.S.A. 65-2836(p).
5. The licensee has violated a federal law or regulation relating to controlled substances.K.S.A. 65-2836(q).
6. The licensee has surrendered a license or authorization to practice the healing arts in another state or jurisdiction, has surrendered the authority to utilize controlled substances issued by any state or federal agency, has agreed to a limitation to or restriction of privileges at any medical care facility or has surrendered the licensee's membership on any professional staff or in any professional association or society while under investigation for acts or conduct similar to acts or conduct which would constitute grounds for disciplinary action under this section.K.S.A. 65-2836(u).

WHEREFORE, under the provisions of K.S.A. 65-2838(b), the Board has the authority to issue this Enforcement Order in lieu of holding hearings in the case.

WHEREFORE, Applicant's license to practice osteopathy should be REINSTATED, subject to the following conditions, restrictions and limitations:

- a. Applicant's license is RESTRICTED to the practice of industrial medicine and blood bank supervision. Any changes in current employment should be reported within five days of Applicant's knowledge of such change. This reporting is required in order to monitor compliance with the restrictions on

Applicant's license, not for approval of such changes.

- b. Applicant agrees to provide to Kansas copies of compliance reports required to be submitted pursuant to Missouri Order dated June 26, 1996, paragraph 11.
- c. Applicant agrees that any positive results from random biological fluid testing as required for the Missouri Order dated June 26, 1996, be reported within five days to Kansas.
- d. All reporting should be addressed to Assistant General Counsel, Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, 235 S. Topeka Blvd., Topeka KS 66603-3068.

These restrictions shall be in effect for a period of at least two (2) years. Applicant may petition the Board for termination of this Stipulation after the expiration of such two-year time period.

This document shall be deemed a public record when fully executed by both Applicant and the Board, and shall be reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank, Federation of State Medical Boards and any other reporting entities requiring disclosure of this Stipulation.
