**JOURNAL ENTRY AND FINAL ORDER**

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with the Kansas Occupational Therapy Practice Act, K.S.A. 65-5401, *et seq.*, and the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon due consideration of the agency record in the above captioned matter and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. On or about November 15, 2011, Brant Willoughby, O.T.A. (“Applicant”) submitted to the Board an application for a license to practice as an occupational therapy assistant in the State of Kansas. Such application was deemed complete and filed with the Board on February 16, 2012.

2. On or about February 28, 2012, Applicant signed a Consent Order as a condition to being granted licensure as an occupational therapy assistant in Kansas. The Consent Order was filed with the Board on April 5, 2012.

3. The Consent Order provided for a temporary license pending ratification of the Consent Order by the full Board and contained requirements for Licensee to participate in monitoring

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4. Upon signing the Consent Order, Applicant verified that he understood that the Temporary License was only effective until a conference hearing was held by the Board on ratification of the Consent Order, and if the Board failed to ratify the Consent Order, the Temporary License would immediately expire at the conclusion of such hearing.

5. The Consent Order was scheduled to be presented to the Board for ratification at its regularly scheduled Board meeting on June 22, 2012.

6. On or about June 15, 2012, Executive Director Selzler Lippert received an e-mail from Applicant requesting an extension of his temporary license and a continuance of the presentation of his Consent Order for the Board's consideration for ratification.

7. On or about June 19, 2012, Executive Director Selzler Lippert denied Applicant's request for continuance upon a determination that Applicant had not complied with the monitoring provisions in the Consent Order.


8. Subsequently, Applicant informed Associate Litigation Counsel that he no longer wished to obtain licensure in the State of Kansas.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that the Consent Order filed in the above-captioned matter is not ratified by the Board.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Consent Order's effectiveness and Applicant's temporary license expired on June 22, 2012.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that based upon Applicant's request, his application for licensure to practice as an occupational therapy assistant in the State of Kansas is considered **WITHDRAWN**.
