FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 14th day of August, 1999, comes on for consideration before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") sitting as a whole in a conference proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 77-553 through 77-535 the application of Sharon Dale Wilson, (hereafter "Applicant") to practice as a respiratory therapist in the state of Kansas. Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presented information before the Board. There were no other appearances.

After reviewing the application and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On May 6, 1999, Applicant filed an Application For Registration In Respiratory Therapy to practice as a respiratory therapist in the state of Kansas.
2. As part of the application, Applicant failed to provide a notarized copy of her diploma and an official transcript of college record from Menorah Medical Center School of Respiratory Therapy, Kansas City, Missouri. Menorah Medical Center School of Respiratory Therapy is no longer in existence.

3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5506, an applicant for registration as a respiratory therapist shall present evidence satisfactory to the board of having successfully completed the academic requirements of an educational program in respiratory therapy recognized by the board.

4. K.A.R. 100-55-1(b)(2) and (3) requires each applicant for registration as a respiratory therapist to submit with the application an official transcript from a recognized educational program and a notarized copy of a diploma from that program.

5. The information provided by Applicant does not provide satisfactory evidence of having successfully completed the academic requirements of an educational program in respiratory therapy.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The failure of Applicant to comply with K.S.A. 65-5506 and K.A.R. 100-55-1 constitutes grounds for which the Board may deny an Application For Registration In Respiratory Therapy to practice respiratory care in the state of Kansas pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5506.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE BOARD as follows:

A. That the findings herein above made be and the same are made the Order of the Board.

B. Based upon the Applicant's failure to provide an official transcript of college record and a notarized copy of the diploma from that program, Applicant has not presented satisfactory evidence of having successfully completed the academic requirements necessary to obtain a registration to practice as a respiratory therapist and Applicant's Application For Registration In Respiratory Therapy is **DENIED**.

C. This is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within 15 days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


