ORDER RESCINDING STIPULATION AND ENFORCEMENT ORDER

NOW, on this 15th day of June, 1990, this matter comes for consideration by the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts at the request of Alvin E. Wolfe, D.O. (hereinafter referred to as "Licensee") for rescission of Stipulation dated May 9, 1989. Joseph M. Furjanic, Disciplinary Counsel for the Board appears as well as Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., General Counsel to the Board. There are no other appearances.

After reviewing the investigative file and being duly advised in the premises, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter referred to as "Board") makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

1. That, on or about November 8, 1988, information was provided to the Disciplinary Counsel for the Board alleging that Licensee may have committed certain acts which could constitute one or more violations of the Kansas Healing Arts Act.

2. That, on February 11, 1989, the Board found reason to believe Licensee has committed one or more violations of the Kansas Healing Arts Act and directed that disciplinary action be initiated.

3. That, on February 13, 1989, a Petition for Revocation,

Suspension or Other Disciplinary Action was filed by the Disciplinary Counsel for the Board.

4. That, in lieu of the prosecution of formal charges at a hearing, the parties entered into a Stipulation dated and effective May 9, 1989 and an Enforcement Order dated May 12, 1989 based upon said Stipulation was issued by the Board.

5. That, Licensee successfully completed the program entitled, "The Proper Prescribing of Controlled Dangerous Substances", at the Mini-Residency sponsored by the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey - School of Osteopathic Medicine, Camden, New Jersey between May 1 through 6, 1989 as required by the Stipulation.

6. That, Licensee has supplied the Board with reports regarding Licensee's compliance with proper prescribing procedures as agreed in the above-mentioned Stipulation.

7. That, Licensee has participated in clinical work consisting of a Mini-Residency as agreed in the above-mentioned Stipulation.

8. It appears, Licensee has fully complied with all of the requirements placed upon him as set forth in the Stipulation.

9. Licensee has requested the Board to grant rescission of the above-mentioned Stipulation.

10. That, the Stipulation of May 9, 1989 between the Board and Licensee and the Enforcement Order issued by the Board of May 11, 1989 should be rescinded and hereafter of no further force and effect.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE BOARD sitting in regular






