STIPULATION

Now on the 18 day of May, 1982, an agreement is entered into by and between the State Board of Healing Arts, hereinafter known as H.A.B., and Robert D. Wood, M.D., hereinafter known as Wood.

WHEREAS, an administrative hearing was commenced and an evidentiary hearing concluded on or about October 3, 1981; and,

WHEREAS, it is the intent and understanding of the parties hereto to join in full compliance with terms and conditions herein set forth; and,

NOW IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AND UNDERSTOOD, as follows:

1) That Wood has and will continue being engaged in a Fellowship at Wesley Hospital, Wichita, Kansas for a period of up to one year;

2) That any and all practice conducted by Wood while engaged in the Fellowship at Wesley Hospital, Wichita, Kansas, shall be related to the Fellowship and at the direction of those in charge of the Fellowship;

3) The H.A.B. will make the decision concerning Wood's completing the Fellowship prior to one year, with considerable weight being placed upon the recommendations and report to be given H.A.B. by those operating the Fellowship concerning Dr. Wood's activity and progress regarding the Fellowship program.

5) That Wood will comply with any reasonable request of the H.A.B. who might, in its discretion, require from time to time a progress report or status report concerning Wood's activities;

6) That it is fully understood and agreed that any and

all changes or amendments to any conditions herein set forth shall be in writing and mutually agreed upon by and between the parties;

7) That the parties hereto are aware of and acknowledge receiving a Report of the Hearing Panel, which recommended the basis for the execution of this Stipulation.

8) That the parties understand and agree that upon full compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Stipulation, Wood's license will remain in full force and effect;


9) The parties further understanding and agreeing that the above-described terms and conditions are intended to be, and so understood by Wood, a lawful order or directive of the Board as set forth in K.S.A. 65-2836 (o), with it further being understood and agreed that should any of the terms and conditions be violated, the Board may, in its discretion, commence an administrative hearing pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2836 (o).

10) That the cost of the hearing in the sum of \$160.00, shall be paid by Wood, full payment to be made by no later than May 1, 1982.

It is the expressed hope of the parties hereto that the terms and conditions herein set forth are in the best interests of all parties and will be fully complied with.




