FINAL ORDER GRANTING LICENSURE BY ENDORSEMENT

NOW on this 14th day of June 2013, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the application of Sarah I. Woodrow, M.D. ("Applicant") for a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Applicant appears via teleconference and pro se. Seth Brackman, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801, et seq. and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501, et seq., the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

- 1. On or about March 3, 2013, Sarah I. Woodrow, M.D. ("Applicant") submitted an application to the Board for a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Such application was complete and filed with the Board on April 9, 2013.
2. Applicant graduated from medical school in 2000, from the University of Toronto in Ontario, Canada.
3. Applicant passed all 3 steps of the USMLE within 10 years.
4. Applicant has not completed any ACGME accredited postgraduate training.

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5. In June of 2008, Applicant successfully completed an 8-year residency in neurological surgery at the University of Toronto in Ontario, Canada. The residency was accredited by the RCPSC. In 2009, Applicant completed a one-year fellowship in spinal neurosurgery at the University of Miami.


6. In 2009, Applicant was granted full licensure to practice medicine and surgery in New Jersey. Applicant's license is currently active with no disciplinary actions.

7. Since 2010, Applicant has been practicing as an Assistant Professor of Neurosurgery at Cooper University Hospital in Camden, New Jersey. Her position includes staff privileges and an in-office practice where Applicant regularly sees and treats patients.

8. The Board finds that the Applicant has demonstrated satisfactory fulfillment of of the active practice requirement of K.S.A. 65-2833 to be granted a license by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that Applicant is hereby granted a license by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.


