ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY PERMIT

NOW, on this 28TH of April, 2001, this matter comes on for conference proceedings before the full Board at the request of Carl L. Woofter (hereafter "Applicant") to grant extension of a temporary permit pursuant to K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 65-28a07.

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board"). Applicant does not appear.

After reviewing the file and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

1. Applicant graduated from the Wichita State University Physician Assistant program July 28, 2000.
2. Applicant was issued a temporary permit on August 18, 2000 and that permit was to expire April 28, 2001.
3. Applicant did not pass the NCCPA examination in October, 2000.
4. A request for extension of the temporary permit was received from Applicant on February 19, 2001.
5. Informal notification by way of a letter received by facsimile on April 27, 2001 indicated NCCPA granted certification to Applicant on April 25, 2001. Formal notification pending.
6. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-28a07, which became effective February 1, 2001, a

temporary license (previously called a temporary permit) may be extended upon a majority vote of the members of the Board.

7. The Board finds sufficient cause exists to grant Applicant an extension of his temporary permit.
8. Applicant should be granted an extension of temporary permit to expire on the date the official results from the April, 2001 NCCPA examination are made available or on August 15, 2001, whichever should occur last.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. That an extension of temporary permit be granted to Applicant to expire on the date the official results from the April, 2001 NCCPA examination are made available or on August 15, 2001 whichever should occur last.
2. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service of the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
