FINAL ORDER

NOW, on this 21st day of June 2008, comes on for conference hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the request filed by Clifford Wright, D.C. (“Licensee”) to terminate the requirements imposed by the Final Order filed on June 13, 2007. Licensee appears *pro se* by telephone. Dan Riley, Associate Counsel, appears for the Board.

After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements of the parties, and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. On March 15, 2007, Licensee submitted an application to the Board for a license to practice chiropractic.

2. Licensee had not completed any courses or examinations in physiotherapy. On June 13, 2007, the Board issued a Final Order conditionally granting Licensee a license to practice chiropractic in the state of Kansas.

3. Pursuant to the Final Order, Licensee’s practice is limited to adjusting misplaced tissue with no administration of physiotherapy. Licensee is required to sit and pass the elective physiotherapy examination administered by the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners (“NBCE”) within one (1) year following service of the Final Order.

4. On May 19, 2008, Licensee filed a letter requesting that the limitations on his license be terminated.

5. As part of his request, Licensee provided evidence of having successfully passed the NBCE physiotherapy examination.

6. Licensee has successfully completed the conditions imposed upon him by the Final Order.


7. Licensee has demonstrated sufficient evidence regarding his competency to practice physiotherapy.

8. The limitations and requirements imposed upon Licensee in the Final Order should be terminated.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee's request to terminate the limitations and requirements imposed by the Final Order filed on June 13, 2007 should be granted.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a Petition in District Court as authorized under the Kansas Act for Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement of Agency Actions, K.S.A. 77-601 *et seq.* A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the Final Order. A copy of any such petition must be served upon the Board addressed to the Executive Director, 235 S. Topeka Boulevard, Topeka, Kansas 66603. A request for reconsideration is not a prerequisite for judicial review.


