FINAL ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION


NOW on this 8th day of August, 2014, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the application of Donghua Xie, M.D. (“Applicant”) for a licensure by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Applicant appears in person and *pro se*. Reese Hays, Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, the evidence presented, and hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. On or about March 10, 2014, Donghua Xie (“Applicant”) submitted an application to the Board for a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Such application was filed with the Board on June 30, 2014.
2. Applicant’s application requested a license by endorsement based on his license in the State of Michigan.
3. During the conference hearing, Applicant requested the Board grant withdrawal of his application for licensure by endorsement.
4. The Board accepts such withdrawal of Applicant’s application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS, that Applicant's request to withdraw his application for licensure by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas is hereby accepted.


