FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 14th day of February, 1998, this matter comes on before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter referred to as "Board") sitting as a whole, the application of Marina V. Yaroshenko, M.D., (hereinafter "Applicant") for a permanent license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

Applicant appeared in person <u>pro</u> <u>se</u>. Charlene Abbott, Licensing Administrator of the Board, presented information to the Board.

After reviewing the file, hearing statements and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

- 1. On May 22, 1997, Applicant filed an Application For Endorsement to obtain a permanent license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.
- 2. As part of that application, Applicant provided information and documentation regarding medical training and education which had been obtained by Applicant. The information provided by Applicant reflected she graduated from Riga Medical Institute, Latvia (formerly USSR) in 1986 and was granted a "Medical Doctor" diploma.
- 3. Applicant has repeatedly tried to obtain a transcript of professional school and a notarized copy of her school diploma, but due to an unstable political situation in Latvia, she has been unsuccessful and requests waiver of the Section X requirements of the Application for Endorsement.
- 4. Applicant has provided a verification of current licensure from the state of California and is eligible for a license by endorsement under K.S.A. 65-2833.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the requirements of Certification of Professional College or Section X of Applicant's Application for Endorsement is hereby waived.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that waiver of the Section X requirements does not constitute approval of Applicant's Application for Endorsement, nor does it constitute a waiver of any other requirement of the application.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite to seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
