FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW on this 11th day of December, 1992, comes on for consideration by the conference proceeding before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") sitting as a whole the request of Mueeza Razzaque Zafar, M.D. (hereafter "Applicant") for the Board to waive the section X requirement of the application filed by Applicant.

After reviewing the file and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, and order:

1. On September 3, 1991, Applicant filed an application for endorsement license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.

2. As part of that application, Applicant indicated that Section X of the application entitled "Certificate of Professional College" had not been completed since Applicant had graduated from the Fatima Jimmah Medical College for Women in Lahore, Pakistan and that contact with that medical school was virtually impossible.

3. That at its meeting June 12, 1992 the Board ordered staff to take no action on Applicant's application for permanent

license but that Applicant be granted a temporary permit to allow her to work outside of her residency program for six months during which time she was instructed to make renewed efforts to obtain documentation which would, as nearly as possible, meet the requirements of Section X of the aforementioned application, said efforts to include contact with the American Medical Association National Credentialing Verification Service (NCVS).

4. That on November 24, 1992 a Notice of Conference Hearing was served upon Applicant to appear before the Board and show proof of meeting the requirements of Section X or, in the alternative, show just cause why she was unable to fulfill this requirement.

5. Prior to the Board meeting of December 11, 1992, Board staff received adequate documentation from Applicant to meet the Board's requirements of Section X.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

A. That the findings here and above made be and the same are made the Order of the Board.

B. That Applicant's request for waiver of Section X of the application for permanent license is no longer at issue based on Applicant's ability to fulfill the requirements of Section X of the application and the application for permanent license is granted.

C. This is an Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service of this Order file a Petition for Reconsideration. A

Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
