FINAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS Fourteenth Day of December 2002, comes before the Board an application by Suhaib Adil Zaniel, M.D. for a license to practice medicine and surgery. Applicant does not appear. Kelli J. Benintendi, Associate Counsel, is designated to appear for the Board.

Having the agency record before it, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. Applicant submitted an application for a license to practice medicine and surgery. He identified the College of Medicine, Baghdad University, Baghdad, Iraq as the school of medicine from which he graduated.
2. Applicant is unable to obtain a professional certification from the medical school.
3. The Federation Credential Verification Service is unable to obtain documentation from the medical school.
4. Applicant makes a written request that he be allowed to withdraw his application.
5. The Board finds that it is appropriate to allow Applicant to withdraw his application.


IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the application for a license to practice medicine
