**FINAL ORDER ALLOWING  
APPLICATION FOR REINSTATEMENT**

**NOW ON THIS 10th** day of February, 2007, this matter comes on for hearing of Petitioner's request for consideration of the reinstatement of his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Respondent German Zhitlovsky, M.D. (Petitioner) appears in person and by counsel, Holly Malone. Kelli J. Stevens, Litigation Counsel, appears for the Board.

Having the agency record before it, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. On December 20, 2004, a Final Order was entered wherein Petitioner accepted suspension and surrendered his license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas pursuant to a settlement agreement between Petitioner and the Board.
2. The agreement provides that two years after the effective date of surrender, Petitioner may request that the Board consider reinstatement of his license.


3. As of December 20, 2006, two years will have passed since the surrender of Petitioner's medical license.
4. The Board agrees to allow Dr. Zhitlovsky to file an application for reinstatement of his revoked license.

**IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED** that Dr. Zhitlovsky be allowed to file an application for reinstatement of his revoked license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that this is a final order. A final order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a final order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, et seq. Reconsideration of a final order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the final order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon the Board's Executive Director at 235 SW. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603.
