FINAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS the 18th day of October, 2007, comes on for conference hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the request filed by Ronald J. Zoeller, D.C. (“Respondent”) to terminate the suspension imposed by the Consent Order filed February 12, 2007. Respondent appears in person and through Kevin M. Fowler. Kathleen Selzler Lippert, Associate Counsel, appears for the Board.

After considering Respondent’s request, Petitioner’s response, reviewing the file, hearing the statements of the parties, and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. The suspension imposed upon Respondent should be terminated.
2. The Board finds that the license of Respondent was not renewed within the statutory time frame and his license to practice chiropractic was cancelled on February 1, 2007.
3. If Respondent completes an ‘Application For Reinstatement’, the Board appoints Vinton Arnett, D.C. as the Presiding Officer to conduct necessary proceedings and determine whether and under what circumstances

Respondent is able to practice the healing arts with reasonable skill and safety. Dr. Arnett shall have the authority to issue a Final Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondent's request to terminate the suspension imposed by the Consent Order filed February 12, 2007 is hereby granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Vinton Arnett, D.C. is appointed as the Presiding Officer to conduct necessary proceedings and determine whether and under what circumstances Respondent is able to practice the healing arts with reasonable skill and safety if Respondent submits a completed application for reinstatement. Dr. Arnett shall have the authority to issue a Final Order.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in District Court as authorized under the Kansas Act for Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement of Agency Actions, K.S.A. 77-601 et seq. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the Final Order. A copy of any such petition must be served upon the Board addressed to the Executive Director, 235 S. Topeka Boulevard, Topeka, Kansas 66603. A request for reconsideration is not a prerequisite to judicial review.




