FINAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS Fourteenth Day of August, 1999, comes before the Board the request by David M. Zumalt, D.C. for approval of continuing hours. Dr. Zumalt appears in person. After hearing his statement, and having the agency record before it, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. Dr. Zumalt submitted to the Kansas Chiropractic Association (KCA) evidence of completing a college education course for Emergency Medical Technicians-B. He seeks approval for 70 hours of continuing chiropractic education. KCA approved the course for 24 hours of category II continuing chiropractic education.
2. The KCA approves continuing chiropractic education, and approval by KCA is honored by the Board. This is established by K.A.R. 100-15-2(c). However the Board is the final authority for approving continuing education offerings, and is not bound by decisions of KCA. In this case, Dr. Zumalt has not shown a compelling reason for the Board to conclude differently from KCA.


IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the request by Dr. Zumalt for approval of continuing education hours in addition to those approved by KCA is denied.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective when served. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a

petition for review in the District Court within 30 days following service of the Final order. Any such petition shall be served upon Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director, 235 S. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, Kansas 66603. A request for reconsideration is not a prerequisite to seeking judicial review.
