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**FINAL ORDER GRANTING LICENSURE**

**NOW** on this 8<sup>th</sup> day of August 2014, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the application of Lien Diep, M.D. (“Applicant”) for a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Applicant appears in person and *by and through counsel*, Megan Lewis, of Simpson, Logback, Lynch and Norris, P.A. Reese H. Hays, Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801, *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. In March of 2014, Applicant submitted an application to the Board for a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Such application was complete and filed with the Board on July 1, 2014.
2. Applicant is currently licensed to practice medicine in New York, Pennsylvania, Nebraska, Arizona, Utah and the District of Columbia.
3. Applicant completed four years of ACGME-accredited postgraduate training and is currently in her fifth year of ACGME-accredited postgraduate training.

4. Applicant passed all three steps of the United States Medical Licensing Examination (“USMLE”). She passed Step 1 of the USMLE in September 2000, and passed Step 3 on December, 2010.

5. In order to be granted licensure by examination, K.A.R. 100-7-1(b)(1) requires completion of Step 2 and Step 3 of the USMLE within 10 years after passing Step 1 of the examination.

6. Applicant passed all three steps of the USMLE within 10 years and 3 months.

7. The Board concludes that Applicant has demonstrated substantial compliance with K.A.R. 100-7-1(b)(1) to be granted a license to practice medicine and surgery by examination in the State of Kansas.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS** that Applicant is hereby granted a license to practice as medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.
