FINAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS 12th day of August, 2006, this matter comes on for hearing. Respondent Iris Gonzalez appears in person and through Michael Francis, Attorney at Law. Kathleen Selzler Lippert, Associate Counsel, appears for the Board.

Having the agency record before it, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. The material facts are not in dispute. Respondent has not satisfied all of the duties imposed by the April 10, 2006 Consent Order. Specifically, by May 1, 2006, Respondent was to propose for Board approval a monitoring physician. The monitor was to review patient charts of a sample of patients who received controlled substances, and to report to the Board on a monthly basis.

Respondent's license is limited pending **(Confidential)** Respondent shall not prescribe, dispense or administer any controlled substance while the limitation is in effect.



PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that this is a final order. A final order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a final order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, et seq. Reconsideration of a final order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the final order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon the Board's Executive Director at 235 SW. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603.
