**FINAL ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR  
TERMINATION OF MONITORING**

NOW on this 13th day of December 2013, comes on for conference hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the request of Karen Hall, P.T.A. (“Licensee”) for termination of the monitoring requirements set forth in the Consent Order filed on December 16, 2008. Licensee appears via teleconference and *pro se*. Jane Weiler, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-2901 *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. Licensee is licensed as a physical therapy assistant in the State of Kansas, having been issued License No. 14-00576. Licensee’s license was canceled in 2006 for non-renewal and she applied for reinstatement of her license in 2008.

2. As a condition of reinstatement of her license, Licensee entered into a Consent Order on December 16, 2008, with the Board to resolve concerns regarding Licensee’s disclosure of a criminal conviction history for insufficient funds checks, and **Confidential**

**Confidential** on her application for licensure in the State of Kansas.

3. Confidential

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The Consent Order also required Licensee to submit a practice plan providing details of her place of employment, name of supervisor, and intended means to assure that her clinical skills were adequate to practice.

4. The terms of the Consent Order allowed Licensee to petition the Board for modification or termination after five (5) years.

5. On or about February 26, 2009, Licensee submitted her practice plan to the Board which was reviewed and approved.

6. On or about June 23, 2009, Licensee's supervisor submitted a report to the Board that detailed Licensee's progress and performance.

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
10. On October 24, 2013, Licensee submitted a request to the Board for termination of the monitoring provisions contained in the Consent Order.

11. On November 15, 2013, the Respondent Board filed a Response to Petition for Termination of Monitoring and offered documentary evidence regarding Licensee's compliance with the Consent Order.

12. Based on the evidence presented, the Board finds that Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order and concludes that termination of the monitoring is warranted.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS** that the **MONITORING** requirements imposed by the Consent Order filed on December 16, 2008, are hereby **TERMINATED**.

A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within **30 days** following service of the Final Order. 
