JOURNAL ENTRY OF SATISFACTION OF FINAL ORDER

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon due consideration of the agency record and applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following:

1. On or about March 10, 2014, in accordance with K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 77-537 and 77-514, and as authorized by K.S.A. 65-5510, a Summary Order was issued ordering an indefinite suspension against the license of Elizabeth L. Kuehn, R.T. (“Licensee”) for her violation of the Kansas Respiratory Therapy Practice Act. Licensee shall be Indefinitely Suspended until such time as she provides to the Board proof of successful completion of twelve (12) contact hours of continuing education for a respiratory therapist as required by K.A.R. 100-55-7. Further, Licensee shall be Indefinitely Suspended until such time as she remits to the Board full payment of her civil fine of \$100.00.
2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-542, the Summary Order notified Licensee that if a written request for a hearing was not filed within fifteen (15) days following service of the Summary Order, the Summary Order would become effective as a Final Order upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing.

3. On or about March 31, 2014, the Summary Order became a Final Order, and Licensee's license to practice respiratory therapy in the State of Kansas was suspended.
4. On or about December 31, 2015, Licensee submitted to the Board documentation evidencing completion of the continuing education units required pursuant to the Final Order in KSBHA Docket No. 14-HA00111.
5. Further, on or about December 31, 2015, Licensee remitted full payment of the fine to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts.
6. Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Final Order and, therefore, has no further obligation for compliance.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee is hereby discharged from all requirements of the Final Order filed on March 31, 2014.
