JOURNAL ENTRY OF SATISFACTION OF CONSENT ORDER

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 et seq., as amended, and upon due consideration of the agency record and applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. On or about April 16, 2014, David A. Matheny, D.C., ("Licensee") entered into a Consent Order with the Board for alleged violations of the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801, et seq. The Consent Order required Licensee to attend and successfully complete the Academy of Missouri Chiropractors Continuing Education Seminar from April 4, 2014, through April 6, 2014; and submit to the Board documentation evidencing completion of the continuing education hours within thirty (30) days of successfully completing the course. Further, Licensee was required to attend and successfully complete a Documentation Seminar offered by the Center for Personalized Education for Physicians ("CPEP") by April 30, 2014, and submit to the Board proof of successful completion by May 31, 2014.

2. Additionally, Licensee was to provide to the Board ten (10) additional random charts to be selected by the Board for further review.

3. On or about April 9, 2014, Licensee submitted to the Board documentation evidencing completion of "Medical Record Keeping" offered by CPEP, completed on approximately March 7, 2014. Further, on or about April 9, 2014, Licensee submitted to the Board documentation evidencing completion of "2014 Postgraduate Education" offered by the Academy of Missouri Chiropractors, completed on approximately April 4, 2014, through April 6, 2014.

4. On or about June 10, 2014, Licensee submitted to Board a list of Licensee's patients for the Month of May 2014.

5. On or about June 11, 2014, Board staff submitted to Licensee's counsel, Carol Ruth Bonebrake, the names of ten (10) patient charts, selected at random, for the Board's review.


6. On or about June 30, 2014, Licensee submitted to the Board, the requested ten (10) additional random charts selected by the Board for further review.

7. Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order and has no further obligation for compliance.


