COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon due consideration of the agency record and applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. On or about April 16, 2014, Nadir Quinn, R.T., (“Licensee”) entered into a Consent Order with the Board for alleged violations of the Kansas Respiratory Therapy Practice Act, K.S.A. 65-5501, *et seq.* The Consent Order required Licensee to successfully complete twenty-four (24) hours of continuing education hours on or before July 15, 2014; and submit to the Board documentation evidencing completion of the continuing education hours no later than July 31, 2014.

2. On or about June 25, 2014, Licensee submitted to the Board documentation evidencing completion of “A New Look at Respiratory Diseases & Healthcare Trends III” presented by Last Minute CEU’s, for a total of twelve (12) hours of continuing education hours, on approximately June 5, 2014. Further, on or about June 25, 2014, Licensee submitted to the Board documentation evidencing completion of “302: Blood Gas and Respiratory System”

presented by Medical Education Systems, Inc., for a total of fifteen (15) hours of continuing education hours, on approximately June 10, 2014.


3. Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order and has no further obligation for compliance.


