FINAL ORDER GRANTING LICENSURE

NOW on this 13th day of June 2014, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the application of Kari Anne Rawley, L.R.T. (“Applicant”) for a license to practice radiologic technology in the State of Kansas. Applicant appears in person and *pro se*. Reese Hays, Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Radiologic Technologists Practice Act, K.S.A. 65-7301, *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions, and order:

1. On April 14, 2014, Applicant submitted an application for licensure to practice as a radiologic technologist in Kansas. Such application was complete and filed with the Board on April 24, 2014.
2. Applicant has been practicing radiology technology in Missouri since August of 2000. Missouri does not license radiologic technologists.
3. Applicant attended Bethany Medical Center School of Radiologic Technology in Kansas City, Kansas from July 1991 to July 1993.

4. Bethany Medical Center School of Radiologic Technology closed and the hospital was demolished in 2003. At that time, employees were transferred to Providence Medical Center, however, the records from the Radiology Department were lost or destroyed in the move. Consequently, Applicant is unable to provide her official transcripts from Bethany Medical Center School of Radiologic Technology as required by K.A.R. 100-73-2(b)(1)(B).

5. Applicant produced a letter from The American Registry of Radiologic Technologists ("ARRT") stating that she qualified for ARRT examination based upon her education and training in the approved educational program at Bethany Medical Center School of Radiography. This letter also verifies that Applicant passed the examination for radiology in 1993.

6. K.S.A. 65-7305(d)(2) permits the Board to waive education requirements and grant licensure to an applicant who is currently certified by the ARRT.

7. The Board concludes that the education requirements should be waived for Applicant and a license to practice radiologic technology be granted pursuant to K.S.A. 65-7305(d)(2).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that Applicant is hereby GRANTED a license to practice radiologic technology in the State of Kansas.
