FINAL ORDER TERMINATING MONITORING

NOW on this 11th day of April, 2014, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the request of Chad Welter, DC (“Licensee”) for termination of the monitoring requirement contained in the Consent Order filed on March 14, 2013. Licensee appears in person and *pro se*. Jane Weiler, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. Licensee is licensed to engage in the practice of chiropractic in the State of Kansas, having been issued License No. 01-05540.
2. On or about March 14, 2013, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board due to concerns regarding Licensee’s disclosure of an arrest for driving Under the Influence, which occurred in April 2012, as well as Licensee’s failure to disclose a diversion for furnishing alcohol to a minor in 2006. Additionally, Licensee had been practicing chiropractic without a license.

3. On April 26, 2013, the Board accepted and ratified the Consent Order.

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Licensee further agreed to pay a civil fine of

\$2000.

5. The terms of the Consent Order allowed Licensee to petition the Board for modification or termination after one (1) year.

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8. On or about May 16, 2013, through March 13, 2014, Licensee remitted to the Board all required monthly payments towards his fine.

9. On or about March 10, 2014, Licensee submitted a request for termination of the monitoring provisions of the Consent Order.

10. The Board finds that Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order and concludes that termination of the monitoring requirement is warranted in the circumstances.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that the monitoring imposed by the Consent Order filed on March 14, 2013, is hereby **TERMINATED** and that Licensee shall have no further obligation for compliance.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529, Licensee may petition the Board for Reconsideration of a Final Order within fifteen (15) days following service of the final order. Additionally, a party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court, as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, *et seq.* Reconsideration of a Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within **30 days** following service of the Final Order. 
