- II Approval of Minutes from May 20, 2014:** approved (Webb – Way)
- III New Business:**
- A. Introduction of new Council member:** Lynsey Payne is the new Council member. All members introduced themselves.
- B. Standards for determining physical and mental fitness requirements:** Mr. Burns asked if the Board has standards. Ms. Stevens stated that the Board does not but we do have a reason to deny or limit licensure based on reasonable skill and safety. Potential physical and mental fitness could affect reasonable skill and safety. This standard is for all professions that the Board regulates.
- C. How does the current licensure law/practice protocol form address/allow for new and/or “complementary-alternative” treatment techniques:** Mr. Burns provided copies of the current protocol. The current protocol is very general and wanted to know about new treatment techniques. Ms. Stevens stated that “... additional clinical contemporary therapeutic modalities” should cover it. There is no need to change the current protocol form.
- D. Is it appropriate for an EMT, Nurse, or PT to be able to provide aid on the field and return to play care:** Ms. Stevens stated that it would depend on the profession. For example, a concussion would not be in the scope of a Physical Therapist. Mr. Riley stated that they would need to check on each individual practice acts and discuss the issue with the PT Council.
