Need to check his AT license is in good standing with Missouri. He is BOC certified trainer which is important consideration. Motion to approve recommendation that

- D. Board of Certification for the Athletic Trainer (BOC) 2022 Continuing Education Units (“CEU”) and Evidence Based Practice (“EBP”) category. BOC eliminating requirement that CEU include EBP hours. Extensive discussion regarding whether KAR 100-69-10 needs to be changed to account for BOC change. Without revision of Kansas AT CEU regulations - national and state CEU requirements will be inconsistent. Motion to recommend Board eliminate section g of KAR 100-69-10 (Fitzhugh, Stevanus, carried).
