Council requested development of educational material to provide information for moonlighting AT's, delegating MDs, DOs, and DCs and their clients, explaining obligations to provide applicable physician protocols for every practice setting when AT is practicing in PRN-type situations outside of their normal protocol.

B. Discuss potential regulation revisions

1. K.A.R. 100-69-7, Definition of unprofessional conduct.

Compare with other regulations, e.g. K.A.R. 100-76-7. The Council directed Jay Van Blaricum to reconcile the definitions of unprofessional conduct in the LA.c. regulations with the draft for 100-69-7, then circulate the new draft for Council review.

2. K.A.R. 100-69-10, continuing education requirements and online CEU's. Council approved amendments to the regulation removing "correspondence or live" and proposed direct

interaction requirement from category A, home study course continuing education language. (Burns/Way). Council directed Jay Van Blaricum to implement the changes and circulate the new draft for Council review.

3. K.A.R. 100-69-13, travel-to-treat. Council approved removing this draft regulation due to recent legislative intent disfavoring such a provision.
