- A. Radiological Assistants: Ms. Caldwell reported the bill concerning the Radiological Assistants is at the Legislature and looks favorable. Ms. Caldwell stated that the nurses are trying to get in or making a stand-alone to enable their profession to do x-ray procedures. Ms. Caldwell and Mr. Ralph will keep the Board updated on the progress.
- **B.** Unlicensed Radiological Technologist Supervision: Mr. Riley introduced Jesse Woltje and Justin Barney from the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE). Ms. Woltje reported that they have recently visited 6 facilities that were not meeting the state's requirements. Mr. Riley stated that he believes there is a misunderstanding with the term exempt. The x-ray operator is only exempt from licensure but not the requirements for education and any other KDHE requirements. Ms. Woltje stated they have 4 investigators in the state and the hierarchy of investigations is determined by the type of machine and usage. KDHE is in the process of revising their regulations and they want to work with the Board so the regulations for both agencies work well together. Mr. Barney stated that the proposed regulations can be viewed at www.crcpd.org part 5. Ms. Woltje provided the current regulations. Mr. Riley reported from the renewals he identified 10 individuals that provided original or continuing education; however, only 8 of those are still in practice. Mr. Riley requested the Council members to think of a general standard of what continuing education is acceptable and report back at the next meeting.
