- II. Approval of Minutes from February 3, 2016:** Approved (Baird-Hodges)
- III. New Business:**
- A. PT Dry Needling Regulations for Education and Training per SB 363:** Ms. Stevens reported that dry needling has been approved and waiting on the Governor to sign the bill. She recommended starting on the regulations and provided other state regulations and KPTA recommendations on dry needling as a reference. Following a discussion it was motioned to include the KPTA recommendations, Georgia's regulation 490-9-05(a), inform consent and separate procedure note. Approved (Baird-Hodges)
 - B. Request to Supervise More Than 4 PTAs:** Ms. Lenahan provided a letter from the Indian Creek Healthcare Center wanting to supervise 5 PTAs. Approved for 6 months (Baird-Hodges). Ms. Lenahan will notify the Center.

It is her opinion that this was an oversight and she believes the intention was for MDs/DOs/DCs. Ms. Stevens will continue to work on this issue and report back.
