***KSBHA EMERGENCY ACTIONS AND GUIDANCE STATEMENTS TO FACILITATE
IMMEDIATE ACCESS TO CARE DURING THE COVID-19 EMERGENCY
DECLARATION PERIOD***

In light of unique challenges presented by the COVID-19 pandemic, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) has identified ways the Board can contribute to the capacity of our state’s healthcare system to respond to potential spikes in the numbers of patients seeking access to treatment related to COVID-19 consistent with Kansas law and relevant executive orders. The Board will continuously assess the situation as it develops.

CONTINUING EDUCATION DEADLINE EXTENSIONS

The Board is extending continuing education deadlines until 90 days following the termination of the State of Disaster Emergency declaration for licensees who were unable to obtain the required continuing education due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Licensees currently in the renewal process will certify either that you have completed the required CEs, or, if you have not yet completed them, that you understand you are required by law to complete them within 90 days following termination of the State of Disaster Emergency declaration. The Board will verify compliance by auditing an undetermined percentage of renewal applications.
