PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy is to recognize that foreign education in occupational therapy that has undergone and met the requirements of the Occupational Therapist Eligibility Determination (“OTED”) process of the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (“NBCOT”) meets the educational requirements for occupational therapy licensure under K.S.A. 65-5411, K.S.A. 65-5406, and K.A.R. 100-54-2. This policy is intended to be a guidance document under K.S.A. 77-438.

AUTHORITY:

K.S.A. 77-438; K.S.A. 65-5411; K.S.A. 65-5406; K.A.R. 100-54-2.

POLICY:

Foreign education in occupational therapy that passes and completes the OTED process is education approved by the Board for purposes of licensure by examination for occupational therapists.
